




## The Sloyd System of Wood Working

The woods, white birch, cherry, red oak, and white wood, will be abbreviated, W. B., C, R. O., W. W. Their prices are: birch, about 5 per hundred; cherry, 7 per hundred; white wood, 4 to 6. Board measure is twelve inches square (surface measure) and one inch or less in thickness.
